SHASTRI-BRIDGE PROGRAMME (Sanskritavagahani)	Vya./ Sah./ Jyo.	1 Yr.	3500	Any person who wants to study Sanskrit step by step and to improve their communication skills in Sanskrit & wants to build up ability to understand original Sanskrit texts like Bhagvadgeeta, Ramayana etc. can opt for this. Minimum age of 15 Yrs. No upper age limit.	N.A.
4.	SHASTRI (B.A.)	Vya./ Sah./ Jyo.	3 Yrs.	4500 per year	Pass in Prak Shastri or +2/ Intermediate with Sanskrit or Equivalent exam. OR Pass in +2 / intermediate without Sanskrit + passed Shastri Bridge programme / Kovida / Diploma in Sanskrit language.	Candidates having passed intermediate (+2) without Sanskrit, but having basic Sanskrit knowledge (ability of reading, writing and speaking Sanskrit without proper certification) have to pass Shastri-Entrance Test for entry in Shastri. [Note -Those who do not have any background of Sanskrit, may directly apply for Shastri-bridge programme instead of applying for Shastri-Entrance Test.]

ACHARYA BRIDGE PROGRAMME (Shastravagahani)	Vya./ Sah./ Jyo.	1 Yr.	4500	Any Graduate or presently studying at graduation level (Shastri etc) + having Good basic knowledge of Sanskrit OR such knowledge level attained through Shastri-Bridge or by any other means (self study/Gurukula-study etc.) Good basic knowledge of Sanskrit (ability of reading, writing and speaking Sanskrit) is must to enter this course.	N.A.

6.	ACHARYA (M.A.)	Vya./ Sah./ Jyo.	2 Yrs.	6000 per year	Shastri/ B. A. with Sanskrit /Major Sanskrit or Equivalent exam. OR Having completed any Graduation and passed Acharya Bridge Programme of concerned Shastra.	1. Those having any Graduation without Sanskrit, but obtained the knowledge of Shastric texts of Shastri/graduation level by any other means (i.e. self study/Gurukula-study etc.) have to pass Acharya Entrance Test. 2. Those having Shastri or Acharya in one particular Shastra and intend to do Acharya in another Shastra also have to appear for Acharya- Entrance Test of concerned Shastra. (The intention is, the candidates have to prove that they studied basic texts of a particular Shastra in which they want to do higher studies and become Acharya.) [Note -Those who have not studied basic shastric texts/basic principles of a particular Shastra (either in institution, Gurukula or even by self study) are advised not to apply for Acharya-Entrance Test of that particular Shastra. Instead, they may apply for either Acharya Bridge or Shastri- Bridge based on other eligibility criteria and their understanding level of Sanskrit.]
